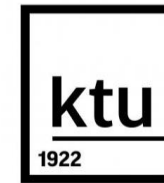

The article should be prepared using *Microsoft Word*. The font for the text should be *Times New Roman*.

The length of the paper should be 4 - 6 pages. At least 75% of the last page must be filled.

After checking the originality, papers will be peer-reviewed by experts of Scientific Committee.

Conference Proceedings will be sent for evaluation into indexing databases: SCOPUS, Conference Proceedings Citation Index (Web of Science), etc.
